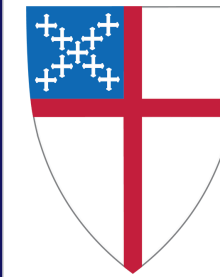
**December 1** - 1st Sunday in Advent and Angel tree is live
