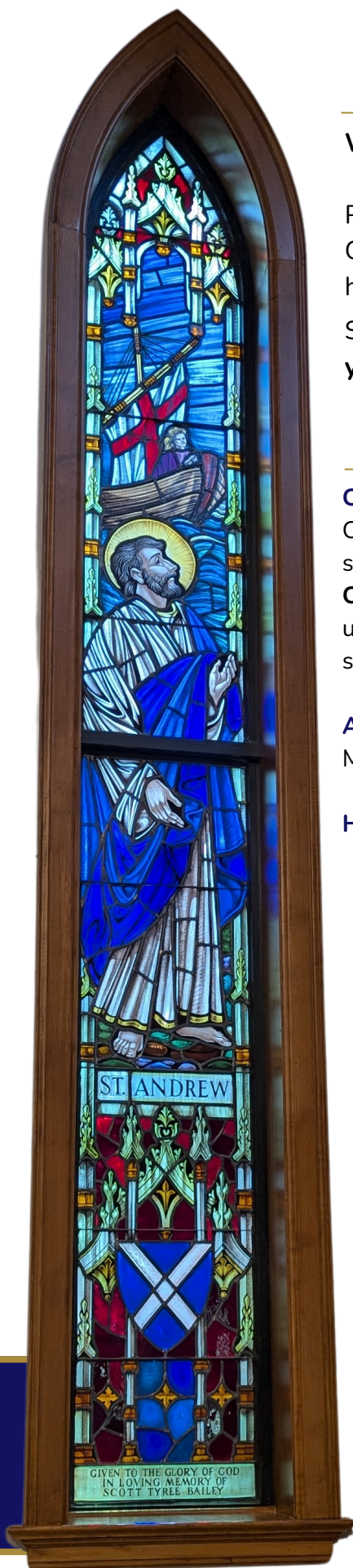

Christmas Flowers

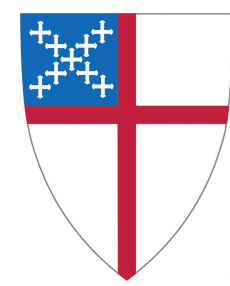
