Pageant Practice Today at 11:45am

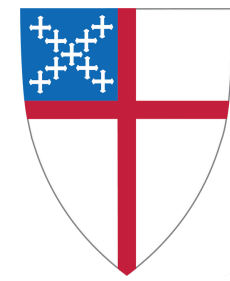
We will be assigning roles, trying on costumes and having a practice run through. Please meet in the Parish Hall following the service.
