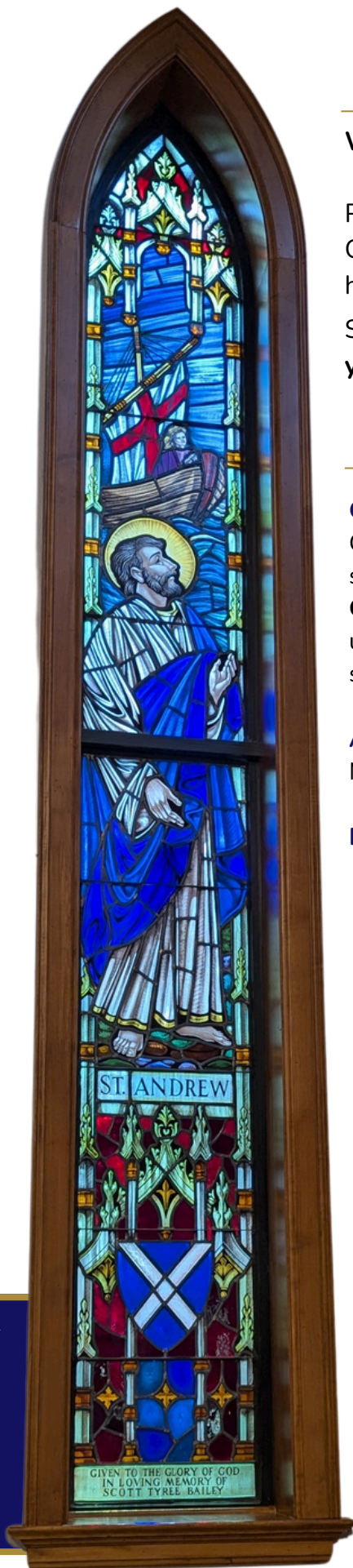

 Church Center is a mobile app and web experience where you can engage with our church throughout the week.






The church has a new app! You can download it now by scanning the QR code!
