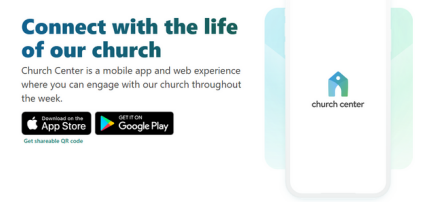

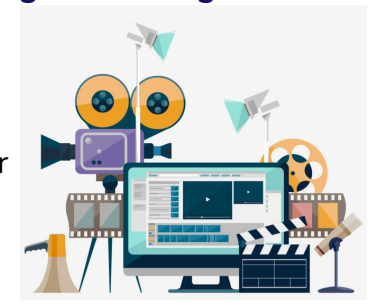

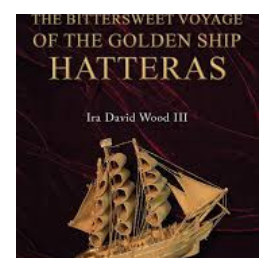
**Video Processing and Editing Volunteer Needed!**

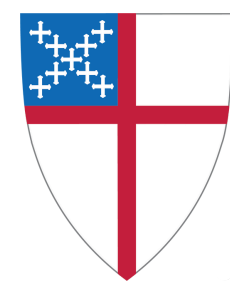
