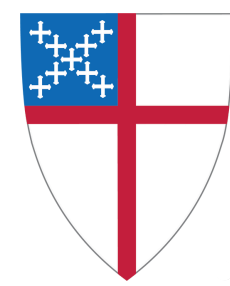
Children's Chapel
