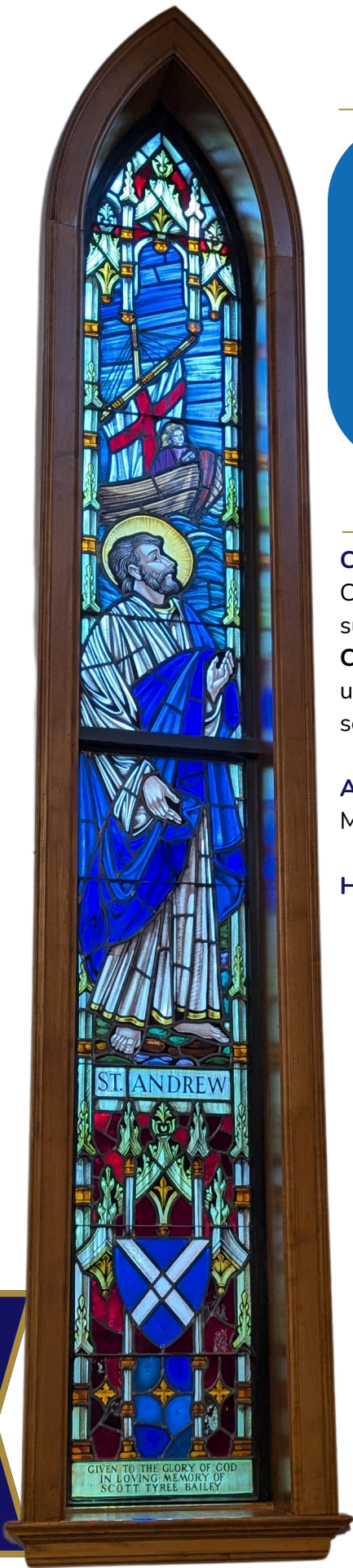

## Planning Ahead

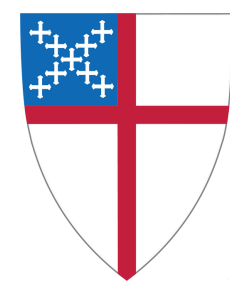
