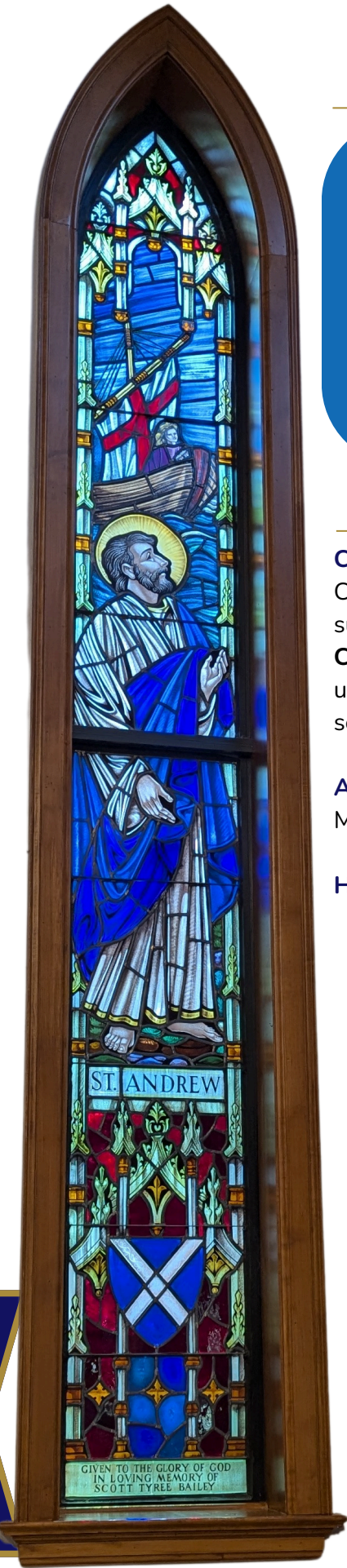

Gatekeepers

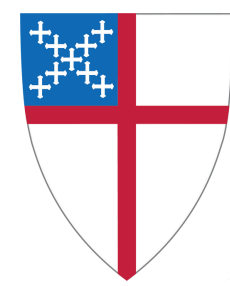
