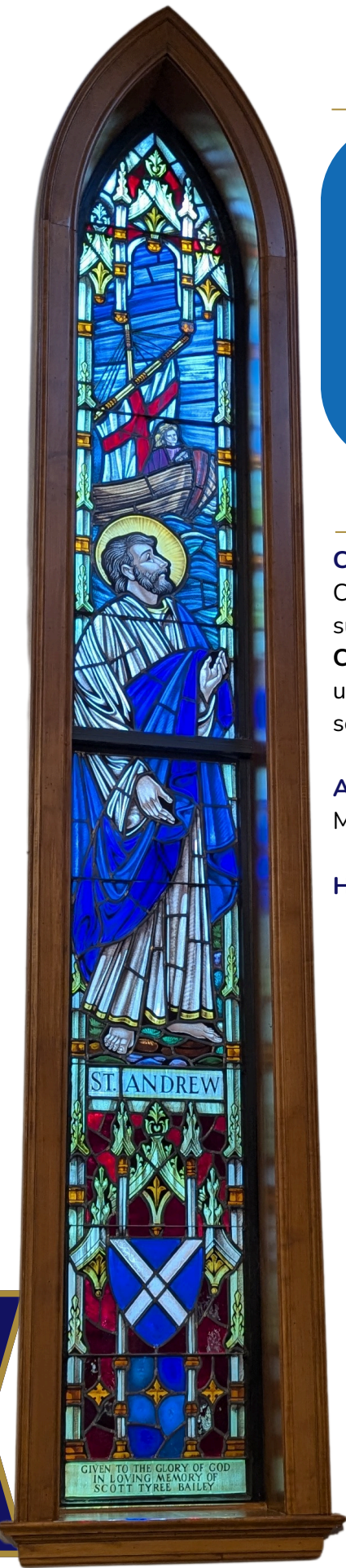

Only one more week to fill out applications! Come by the office to get yours today! Applications are due back in the office by **Tuesday, May 27th.**

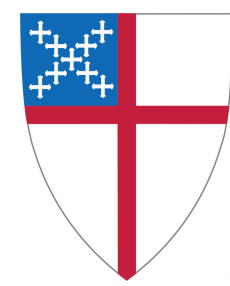
## Summer Mission Trip
