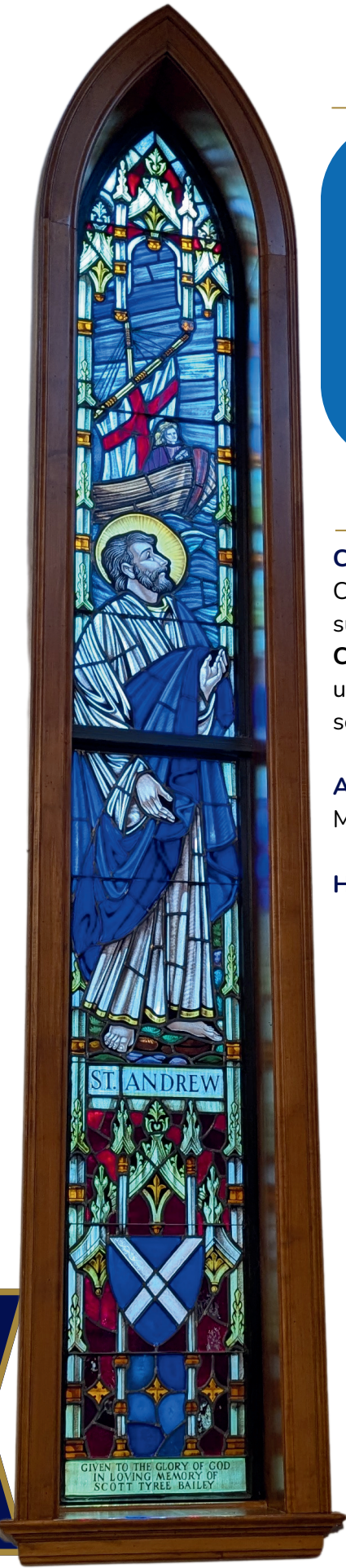

Summer Mission Trip

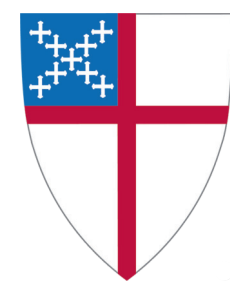
