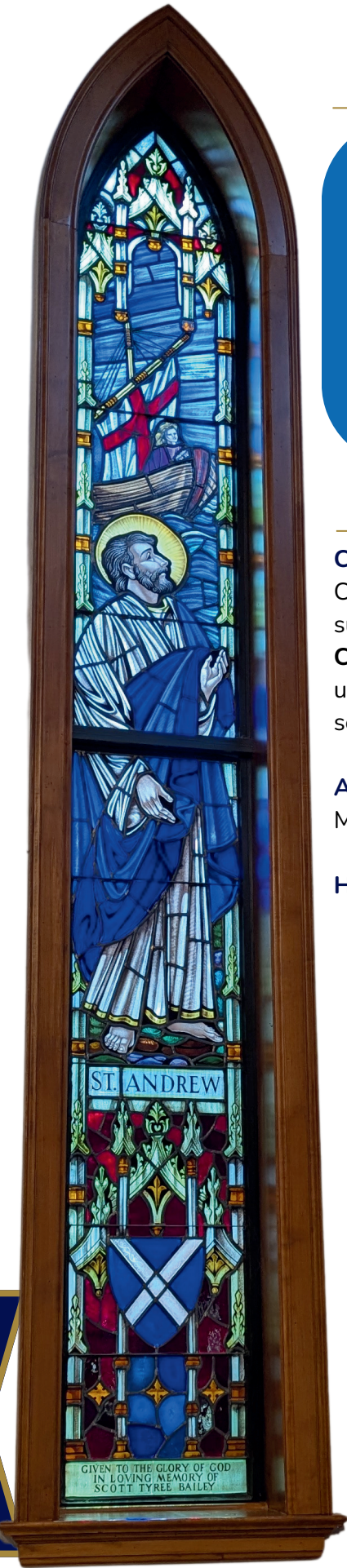
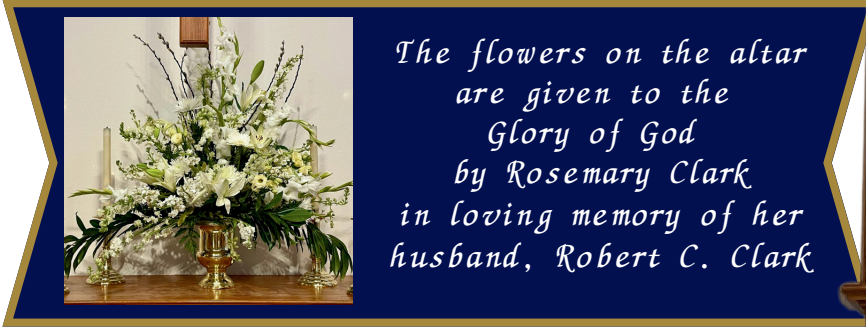

Serving Snacks at 10:15 or lunch at 12:00.

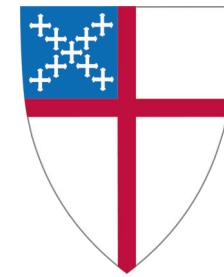
