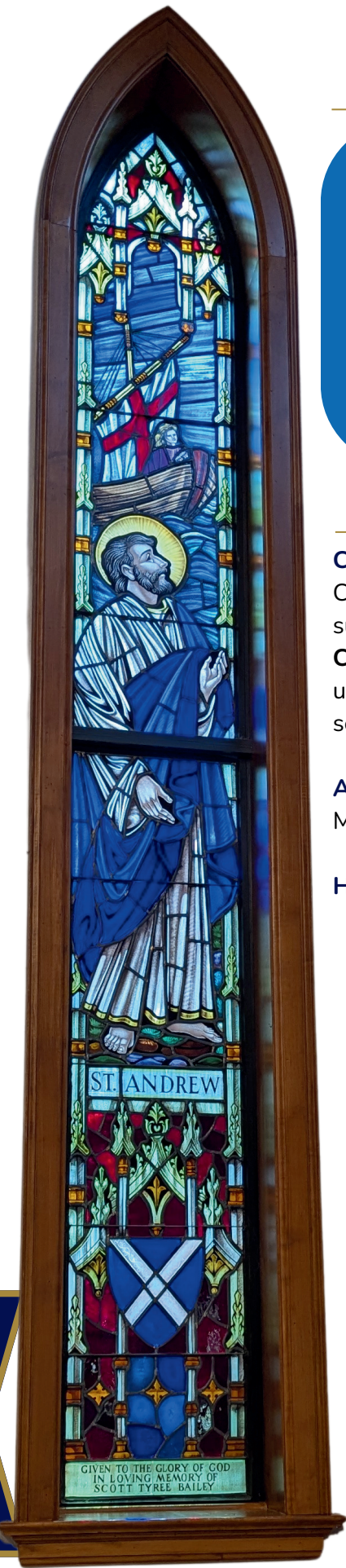

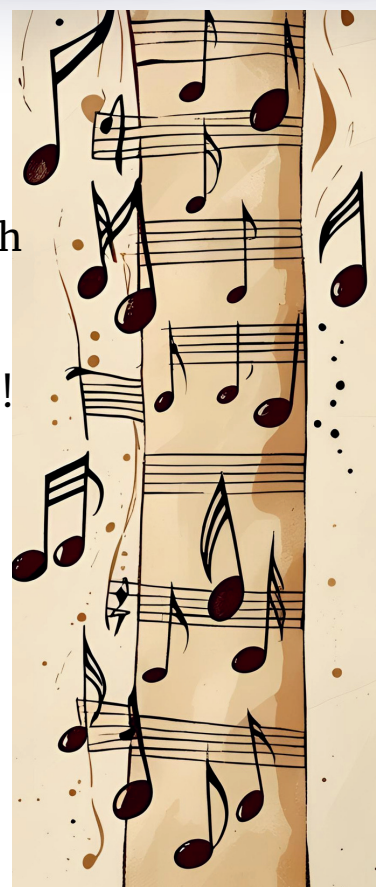

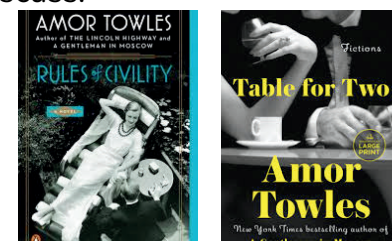

August 3rd return August 10th will be school supplies for Carriage House.

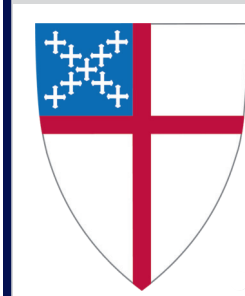
September 7th return September 14th will be toiletry items for the Farmworkers Ministry
