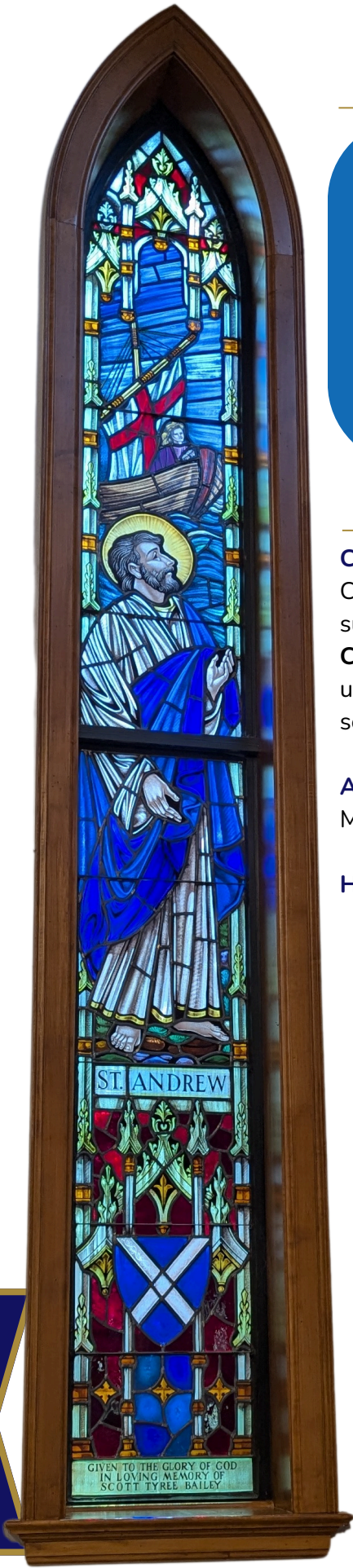

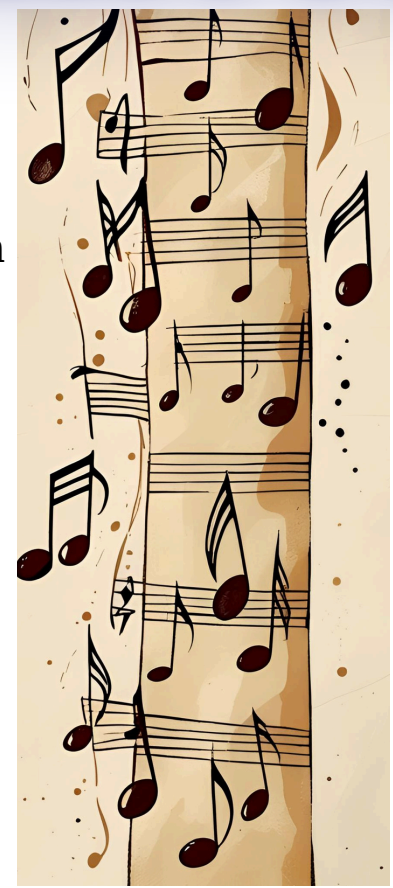

September 7th return September 14th will be toiletry items for the Farmworkers Ministry

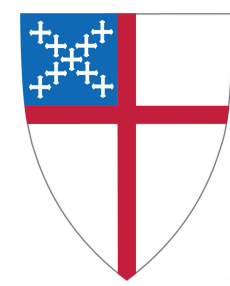
