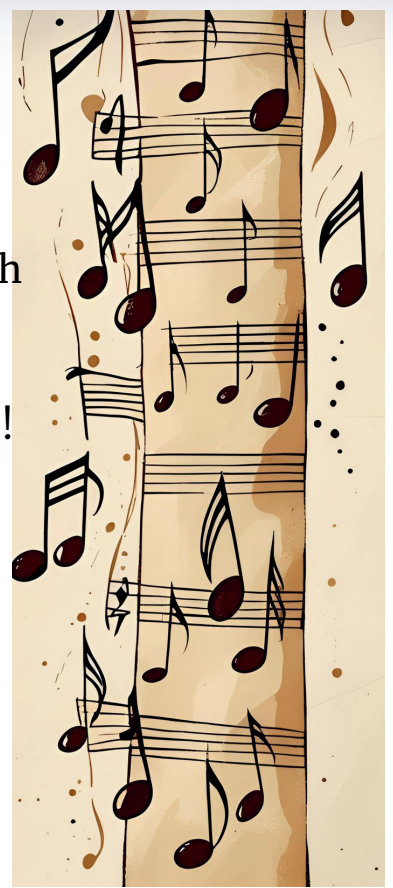

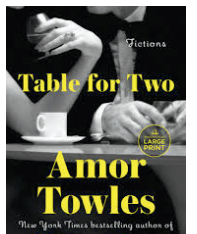
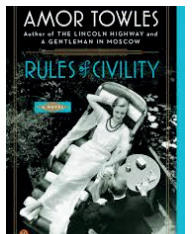

 August 3rd return August 10th will be school supplies for Carriage House.

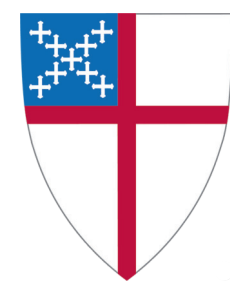
