



Position: Youth Ministry Leader

Job Description:

The Youth Ministry Leader is responsible for developing and maintaining all ministry programs related to middle and high school that are consistent with the vision and core values of Grace.

Position/Pay

- Part time, hourly position. Requiring 10-15 hours per week. Hours include Sundays, Mondays and some Saturdays. The rest of the week is flexible.
- \$17/hour with 2 weeks vacation

Responsibilities:

Coordinate youth ministries (6th-12th grade)

- Serve as a youth advocate. On a regular basis, educating and enlightening the congregation about the hopes, concerns and needs of the youth in the local church and community.
- Recruit, equip, and empower volunteers.
- Create and effectively manage the youth ministry's budget.
- Purchase and prepare materials that are needed.
- Communicate consistently with parents while developing positive relationships with parents and youth.
- Responsible for planning and executing youth retreats and mission trips.
- Leading middle and high school students to encourage their spiritual growth.
- Set up, clean up and reset Crossing in preparation for youth ministry activities.
- Communicate with youth in a Christ-like manner providing positive reinforcement and encouragement.
- Oversee and organize events/fundraising through volunteers.
- Attend staff meetings.
- Communicate with Staff and the Congregation the materials being taught.
- Accountable to and meet regularly with the Lead Pastor.

Qualifications

- 2 years of children's or youth ministry recommended but not required.
- Work productively, both independently and collaboratively with others.
- Able to adapt and evolve to the ever changing needs of ministry.
