

Join us as we walk through the Lenten season and come together on Easter Sunday to celebrate our Risen Lord!

During our "Characters of Easter" Series we are learning more about those who were part of the Easter story. We learned about Peter, The Failure; John, The Beloved; Judas, The Betrayer; and on April 10 Thomas, The Doubter.

Palm Sunday, April 10, marks the Sunday before Easter. This celebrates Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem. Palm Sunday marks the beginning of Holy Week, the remembrance of Jesus' last days to the cross.

Holy (Maundy) Thursday, Christ's final days before being crucified and resurrected. Jesus washed his disciples feet and shared what was known as the Last Supper. Our Holy Thursday service will begin at 7pm on April 17, as we look at Jesus' final prayers. We will also participate in communion, as we recognize what happened during the events of Holy Thursday. Our Lord Jesus was betrayed, tried and crucified the next day on Good Friday.
