Please welcome the Rev. Bill Bennett—he is 67 years old, and grew up in Rocky Mount. His family were members of First Methodist Church in Rocky Mount until 1967 when they joined Christ Church in Rocky Mount where I was Confirmed in the Episcopal Church (the Diocese of NC closed Christ Church in the 90's). He attended RM public schools and ECU where he graduated with a BA in 1978 (and remain a big fan of ECU athletics-Go Pirates!) He was admitted as an aspirant for Ordination in the Diocese of NC in 1990 and received his MDiv from Sewanee in 1994. Bill was ordained to the transitional Diaconate at his home parish of St. Timothy's in Raleigh on 06/24/94, the Feast of the Nativity of John the Baptist, and to the Priesthood at Christ Church, Cordele, GA (Dio of GA) on December 28, 1994, the Feast of the Holy Innocents, where he was serving as Vicar. From 1999-2018 he served as Associate Rector at a downtown Raleigh parish. Rev. Bennett is now retired and serves as part-time Vicar of St. Mark's Church in Roxboro, NC, and also frequently does supply ministry.

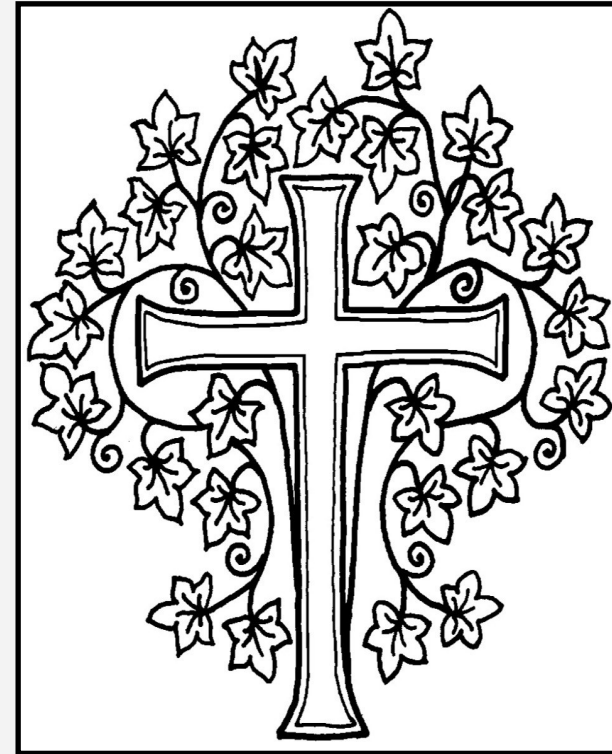
