Help our young ones grow in their faith. We need a volunteer to teach Sunday school once every couple of months during the year. If you are interested, please call or email the church office.

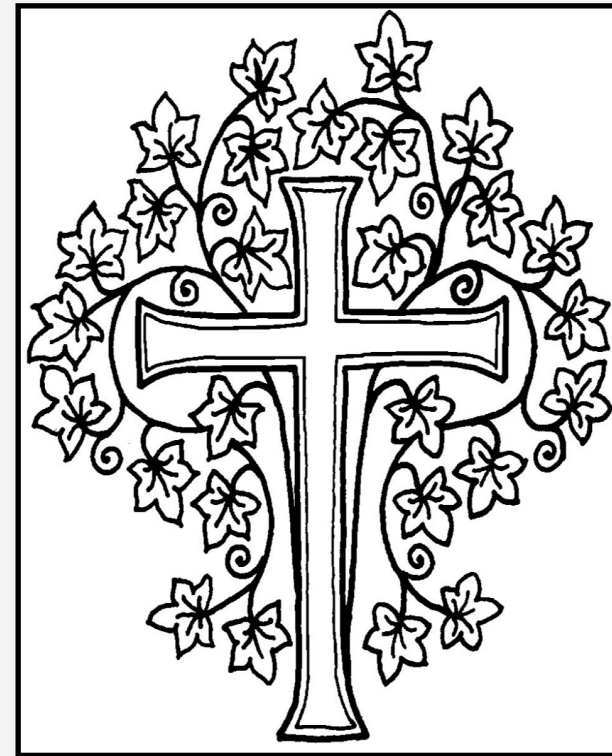
