As you may know, the number of people we now serve in our food pantry ministry has increased exponentially. Please consider making a financial donation to our food pantry so we




are able to buy supplies and keep up with demand.

Starting this Sunday, we will have two chalice bearers. One for intinction (when you dip the bread in the wine) and one for those who would like to drink out of the common cup.


