#### **Going Deeper Into God’s Word**

In Luke, Chapter 4, Jesus gives his stirring sermon in Nazareth. “The Spirit of the Lord is upon me...” to declare release to the prisoners, recovery of sight to the blind, to preach God’s year. Jesus thus signals who God is and what God is up to in the world. God is the one who proclaims, releases, and heals. But then, just a few chapters later, Jesus makes another move. He not only proclaims but sends. In Luke 10, Jesus sends out the seventy, telling them up-front that he is sending them out as lambs among wolves, to speak up and speak out, to heal, cast out demons, and even to raise the dead. In short, Jesus not only performs signs and wonders but also commissions us to do the same work that he does. Jesus is the great delegator. This is the way he does business, ordinary people sent out, doing the same work as he does.
