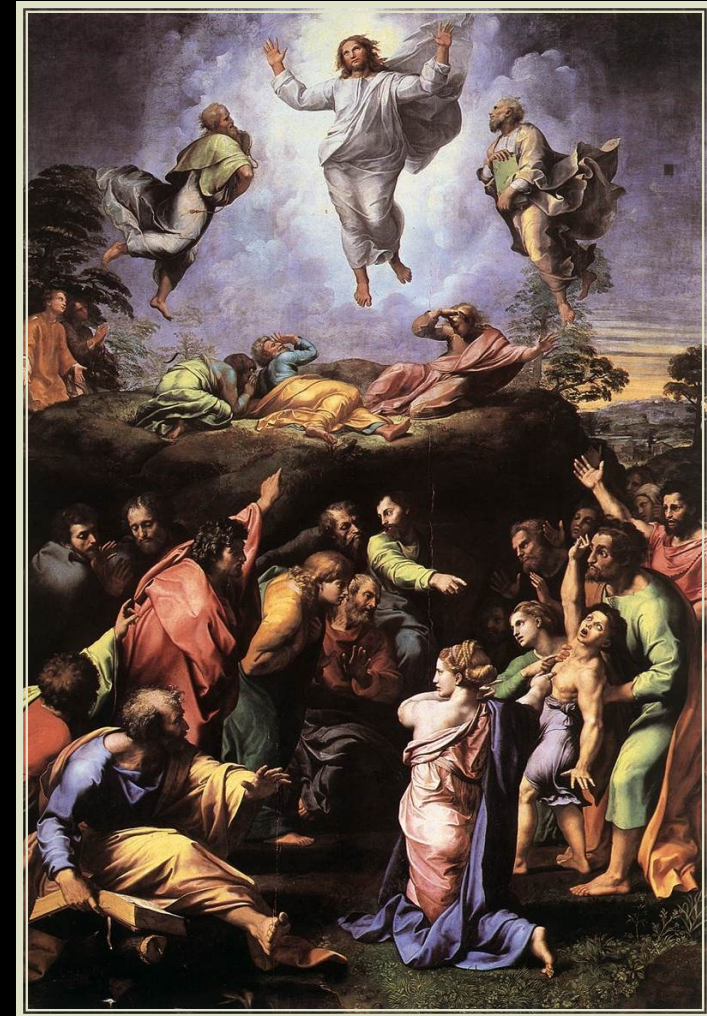
Today we welcome Rev. Earnest Graham!
