Everliving God, whose will it is that all should come to you through your Son Jesus Christ: Inspire our witness to him, that all may know the power of his forgiveness and the hope of his resurrection; let us pray to the Lord. **Lord, hear our prayer.**

For those departed this life in faith and in the fear of God...May they join the innumerable throng of holy ones gathered before the throne and the Lamb, let us pray to the Lord. **Lord, hear our prayer.**

For our nation as we elect new leaders this Tuesday...we pray for wisdom and clear thinking...for honesty and integrity...for a peaceful process...let us pray to the Lord. **Lord, hear our prayer.**

Lord Christ, you have no body on earth but ours, no hands but ours. Ours are the eyes through which your compassion must look out on the world. 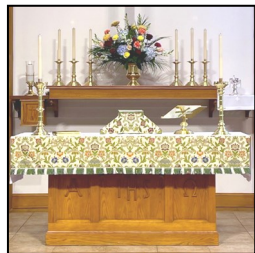
