Blessed are those who have fought the good fight and now share in the wondrous vision God promised from the beginning...May we keep them always in our sight, eager for the day of our joyous reunion. In your mercy. **Hear us, Lord.**

O God, make the door of this house wide enough to receive all who need human love and fellowship, but narrow enough to shut out all envy, pride, and strife.
