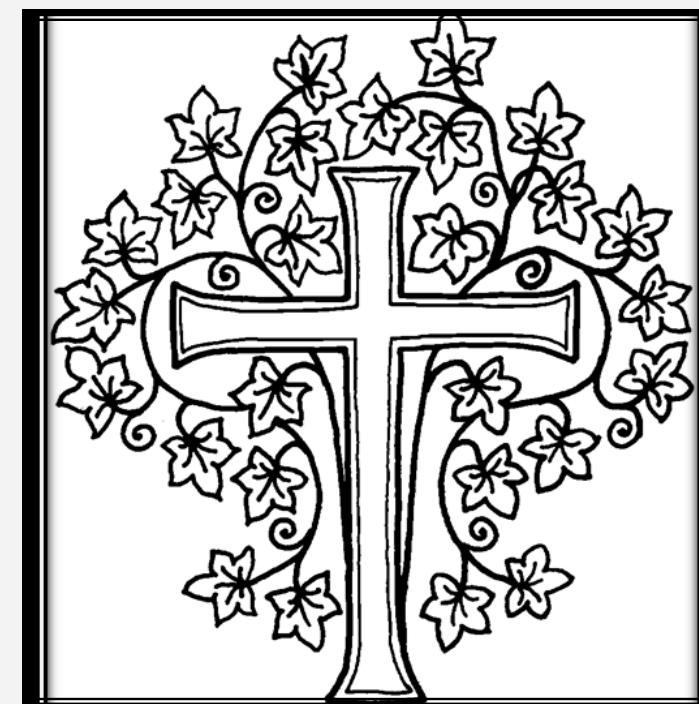

Going Deeper into God's Word

In the final analysis, what do we really know about God's Spirit, the Holy Spirit? Are we as stumped as Nicodemus when it come to our understanding of the role of the Holy Spirit in our life? St. Augustine noted that the Holy Spirit is a gift of God's love. God offers this gift of the Holy Spirit to his son Jesus Christ as a part of handing over all things to him. The Holy Spirit comes from God the Father, but only through Jesus, and it is this same Spirit that is upon Jesus without limit or measure. The Holy Spirit is described in scripture as the "guide into all truth," "the declarer of the things that are to come," even the "many things" Jesus has yet to say which the disciples cannot presently hear. Even so, these things will all glorify Jesus because the Holy Spirit, as John states in Jesus' farewell discourse, "will take what is mine and declare it to you". John 16:12-15
