"In commenting on this passage from Ephesians in *Interpretation*, Paul Eckel writes:

In this time when wars and rumors of war about, when hostilities are deepened because the economy is depressed, when the facts of our lives would lead us to conclude that there are irreconcilable differences among those who call upon the same God, when little minds continue to claim that they alone know the dimensions and limits of Christ compassion, a preacher would do well to attend to this text, tracing Paul's reason back to the foundation of the world when, without distinction, God destined, in love, every family in heaven and on earth to be God's children through Jesus Christ. the proclamation of that truth, which still flies in the face of the facts of our lives, invites all who hear to trust that the one whose love is beyond comprehension, yet made known in Jesus Christ, is the same one who is at work in us, doing far more abundantly than all we ask or think."
